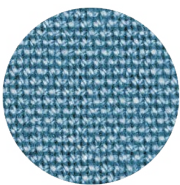


Why Does Thread Count?

A higher thread count indicates a more durable and dense weave, also suggesting an added softness; however, the higher the thread count does not necessarily mean the softer the sheets. *Fabrication* and *construction* also affect the overall texture.

Construction



Percale

A plain, durable, breathable sheet due to its one over, one under weave. The crisp, almost stiff, feel fades after a few washes.



Flannel

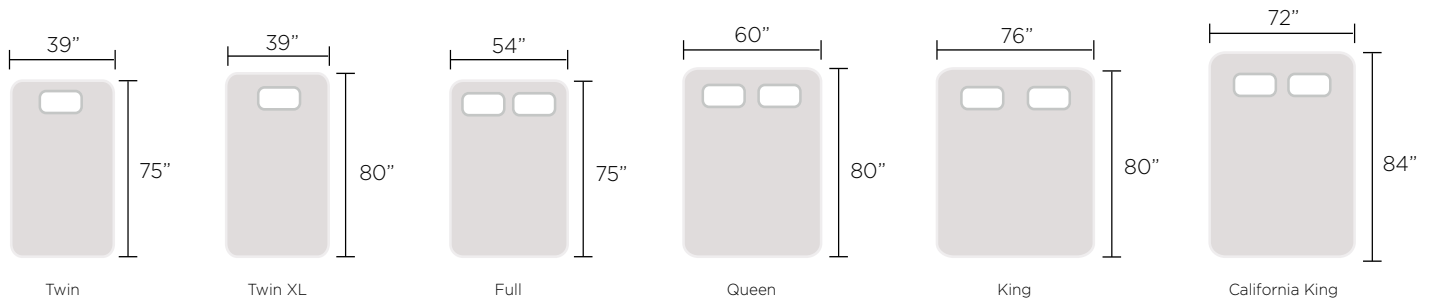
Woven from medium to heavyweight cotton yarns that are napped to give them their soft and fluffy look and feel. The process also opens up the fibers to create air pockets that retain warmth overnight.



Sateen

The unique four over, one under woven construction creates a lustrous look and feel. The long-fiber threads create a soft and silky touch, but may wear and tear faster than other sheets.
