





## Match the Little Red Hen!




Use the cards below to play the Little Red Hen matching game!

# Tootle Needs Your Help Getting Back to the Tracks!






## BONUS IDEA! Create a Tootle Train!






# Can You Find the Shy Little Kitten and Her New Friend?



Connect the dots to reveal the Shy Little Kitten meeting her new friend, the mole. When you're finished, color in your picture!







## Help Scuffy Solve the Secret Message!




